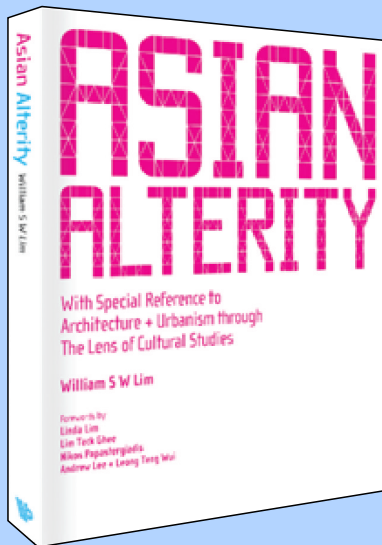


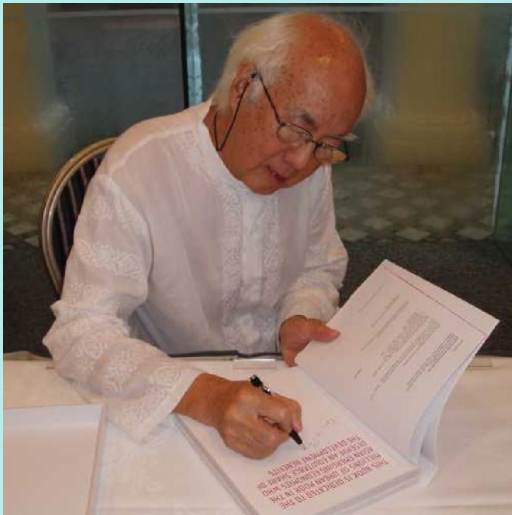
FPA and the “Urban Poor”
